Covid 19 Update – a leaflet was delivered to every home in Fernwood for when the Covid 19 restrictions commenced so every home has the Parish Council details, should the inhabitants become isolated and not have family/friends/neighbours who can help. So far, we've had a handful of calls and been able to arrange prescription collections. NCC's HART team direct people to the Parish Council too. We also have a list of residents who have offered to help. The Parish Council phone has been forwarded to a mobile so the Clerk can attend to calls whilst working from home. The Village Hall is closed. Caretaker doing checks and maintaining the green at Dale Crescent. The builders are repairing the cracks in the changing rooms and will replace the counters if they can obtain the materials required. Legislation now in place to allow remote meetings.
