COSTALL WOODS

The Parish Council continue to explore ways of developing Costall Woods, near the day nursery for the benefit of residents and local wildlife. Last year we met with several contractors on initial ideas, many of whom supported the approach to continue to protect as much as possible and essential tree works when needed. The council continues to be committed to supporting the area and balancing our legal duty to maintain the trees and public safety. In exciting news, we're moving forward with plans for new bird houses to be installed to support several species in the woods, as well as bat houses. We're also moving ahead with the plan to install new bug houses later this summer to support the growth of creepy crawlies in the woodland. Please note, all will be installed to avoid nesting season.



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FERNWOOD SAFARI

Following the success of last year's inaugural event, we are delighted to announce the return of the Fernwood Safari this September. Now in its second year, the Safari has quickly become one of Fernwood's most anticipated community events, bringing residents together for a day of fun, discovery and neighbourly spirit.

The event provides a fantastic opportunity for residents to get involved, showcase their creativity and connect with others across the parish. Whether you're taking part, hosting a stop, hunting for bargains or simply exploring everything Fernwood has to offer, there will be something for everyone to enjoy.

SPORTS PROVISION

The Parish Council's Sports Working Group continues to meet to explore ideas and opportunities for improving sports and recreation across Fernwood. The group recently met with the developers to receive an update on current provision and discuss future plans for sports facilities within the parish.

Importantly, the group is taking a whole-community approach, looking at opportunities across both the established and newer areas of Fernwood. Discussions are focused not only on traditional sports but also on identifying activities and facilities that will appeal to a wider range of interests, ages and abilities. The aim is to ensure that future investment in sports and recreation benefits as many residents as possible, from young children and families through to teenagers, adults and older residents.

The working group welcomes new ideas and will continue to engage with residents and local organisations as plans develop.

DOG POO BINS

One issue raised regularly by residents is dog poo across the village. While the vast majority of dog owners act responsibly, unfortunately there are still occasions where dog poo is not picked up, creating an unpleasant environment for everyone and posing a potential health risk.

We would like to remind all dog owners to please clean up after their pets and dispose of waste responsibly. 🐾

The Parish Council is aware that some areas would benefit from additional dog waste bins and has raised this with the developers, who are responsible for their installation as part of the development plans. We are awaiting an update on when these bins will be installed. In the meantime, if you notice that a dog waste bin has been missed during collections, please contact the Parish Council office so that we can report it and help keep our community clean and welcoming for all.

Dear resident,

We are pleased to be writing to you again in the latest edition of the Fernwood Gazette. We started the last edition by touching on the joy of longer and brighter days, and write this edition sweltering in the punishing heat of June! Our article in this edition is about QR codes, our village's iconic clock tower and how to report anti-social behaviour.

QR Codes

In our last article we shared that we had asked council officers to create QR code stickers for the bins in our village, providing a direct link to the reporting page for when the bin is full or overflowing and needs emptying. We're pleased to share that following our suggestion, officers have taken this initiative up and will soon be rolling this out across a small number of local villages, including Fernwood. We are confident that these stickers will make it much easier and more convenient to report bins that need emptying, and in turn keep our beautiful village clean and tidy.

Fernwood Clock Tower

We have recently been engaging with planning and public protection officers at the District Council about the condition of our village's iconic clock tower. The clock tower is a sign that you're close to home and is an iconic and recognisable feature within our relatively new and growing community. However, concerns have been shared with us and by us about the condition of the building and the security of the site. We have raised these concerns with officers and encouraged engagement with the site owners to push for some progress on the site. We are pleased that access to the site through missing fence panels has been resecured, thanks to the efforts of our public protection colleagues. We are also pleased to confirm that officers have been receptive to engagement with the site owners regarding the future of the site. We are sure that there will be much public interest as and when updates are received, and we will endeavour to share with you any information we receive.

Anti-Social Behaviour

As we progress into nicer and warmer weather (hopefully not always as warm as the end of June!) we want to remind residents of the methods of reporting anti-social behaviour, and the importance of doing so. We have previously explained that resources to tackle anti-social behaviour are allocated based on data driven assessments. That means that if anti-social behaviour is not reported by all who witness it occurring, the appropriate resource to tackle it will not be secured. We have previously pushed for more time and resource to be focussed on Fernwood; however, if the data does not match our representations, resource will not be forthcoming. To that end, if you witness or experience any form of anti-social behaviour in the coming months, and indeed at any time of the year, please do report it directly to Newark and Sherwood District Council's Anti Social Behaviour Team by completing the online form on the council's website, or by calling the customer services team:

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County Councillor Update

It has been a busy few months for Fernwood, with a number of important projects moving forward across our community. The opening of the Southern Link Road is a major milestone that will help improve connectivity and support the continued growth of Fernwood. As new housing developments progress, I am working with developers, Newark and Sherwood District Council, and Nottinghamshire County Council to help ensure the infrastructure needed to support these new homes is delivered alongside them.

One of my key priorities remains the expansion of Fernwood Primary School. This is something I have worked hard to push forward over the last three years, and I continue to press for progress at every opportunity. As Fernwood grows, it is essential that local school places grow with it.

I am also pleased to see highway improvements continuing across Fernwood and the wider Balderton Division. Several road maintenance and repair schemes are now moving forward as part of the investment programme secured through Nottinghamshire County Council. Residents regularly raise concerns about road conditions with me, so it is encouraging to see these long-awaited improvements beginning to be delivered.

My focus remains on getting things done locally—whether that is improving roads, supporting school expansion, securing infrastructure for growing communities, or ensuring residents' concerns are heard.

Fernwood continues to be one of the fastest-growing communities in Nottinghamshire, and while there is still more work to do, I will continue working hard to make sure our area receives the investment and attention it deserves.

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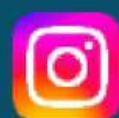
